Kelly Brush Recovering from Skiing Accident



Kelly, the daughter of Mary and Charlie Brush of Charlotte, was injured in a skiing accident during the Williams College winter carnival at Jiminy Peak. A sophomore at Middlebury College and racing for the Panther team, Kelly fell during a giant slalom event, sliding off the race course

and hitting a chairlift stanchion, injuring her back and spine. Lengthy surgery revealed that she had not severed the spinal column and had use of her arms as well as feeling in her upper chest. She has been out of bed, in a wheelchair, and is generally in good spirits. The family has decided to continue her rehabilitation at Craig Hospital in Englewood, Colorado, (craighospital.org) and flew there on Monday.
